



Handy Guide to Measuring Your Space

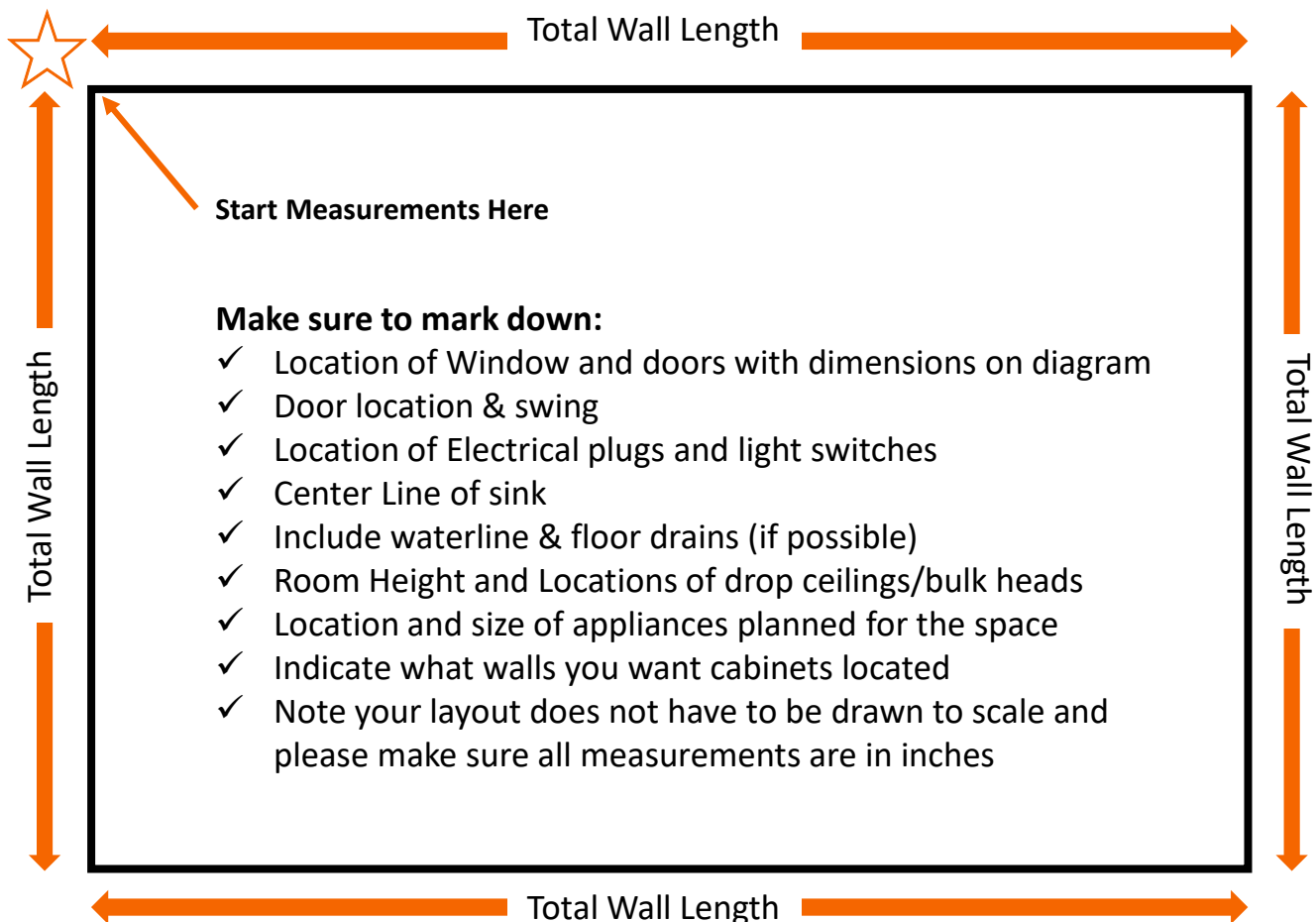


What you'll need:

- Pencil/Pen
- Measuring Tape (Inches)
- Paper

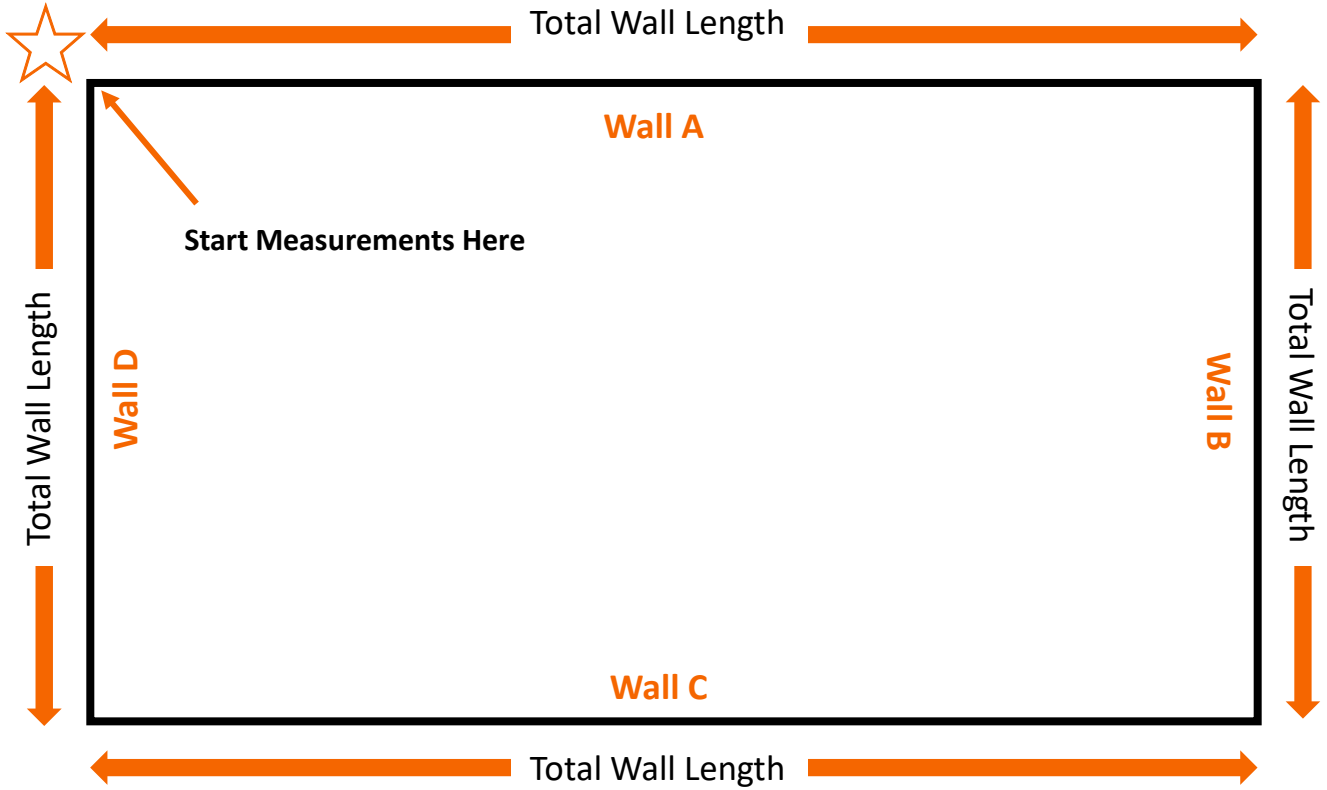
Steps to follow:

1. Start measuring from the corner shown below.
2. Measure the total length of all walls corner to corner.
3. Indicate window and door locations and sizes. Show individual corner to window/door trim dimensions.
4. Indicate door swings, location of electrical plugs, and center line of sink. Include waterline, floor drain locations and confirm the room height and locations of drop ceilings and bulk heads and basement stair header (often in the base corner cabinet).
5. Measure and locate any wall obstacles such as a chimney or vent pop out.
6. Indicate locations and sizes of appliances planned for the space.
7. Double check all dimensions - individuals and totals.
8. Indicate which walls you'd like the cabinets to go and allow breathing room for appliances.
9. Remember a picture is worth a thousand words – its always helpful for our team members to review photos of the space along with the measurements!
